



## *CrossFire Gmelin*

The *CrossFire Gmelin* database is the world's most comprehensive data collection in organometallic and inorganic chemistry, covering literature from the year 1772 to today. As the only major inorganic chemistry database in which the data is derived directly from the primary/journal literature, it is indispensable to the inorganic chemistry faculty and graduate students. Inorganic chemists use the database to find physical property data and reactions on specific chemical compounds, data which cannot be found in any other resource. Access to the *Gmelin* database would greatly enhance our resources in chemistry.
