



## *Eighteenth-Century Collections Online* (ECCO)

Considered the central research tool for 18<sup>th</sup>-century studies, this database has been requested by numerous humanities and social sciences faculty. *Eighteenth Century Collections Online* features 150,000 printed works from the century that saw the American, French, and Industrial Revolutions, and a boom in written materials covering all areas of thought.

According to the publisher, the collection includes “every significant English-language and foreign-language title printed in the United Kingdom, along with thousands of important works from the Americas.” From maps to advertisements, from sermons to plays to medical treatises, this database includes materials from every academic discipline.

Of particular interest are pieces by women writers, materials on the French Revolution, and many editions of Shakespeare’s works. In order for researchers to compare texts, the database provides several editions of each work.
