The *Jean-Baptiste Lully Oeuvres Completes* is of particular interest to scholars of voice, musical theater, and the 17th century. However, Lully's prominence and influence as a composer make this set of volumes an important addition to the music library's main collection and useful to a wide variety of researchers and performers. Jean-Baptiste Lully (1632-1687), star performer and composer in the court of King Louis XIV, is known as the chief French composer of the 17th century. He composed more than fifteen operas, and developed a unique approach to that art form that shaped French musical theater and influenced other composers such as Purcell, Bach, and Handel.
