



The Atlas of North American English (ANAE)

This book and multimedia CD-ROM represent the first comprehensive survey of phonological differences in the way English is spoken across the North American continent. Based on a 1992-99 telephone survey of 762 urban English speakers, *The Atlas of North American English (ANAE)* identifies those features that distinguish U.S. and Canadian regional dialects and outlines linguistic changes that have evolved over time. Attractively designed, the *ANAE* features nearly 130 color maps to illustrate the regional distribution of phonological and phonetic features, accompanied by substantial explanatory text. The CD includes sound samples, a technical improvement over previous publications, which reduces the need to rely on written sound transcriptions. This title will be of considerable use and interest to linguists and dialectologists.
