



## *Dictionary of Modern American Philosophers*

The most comprehensive reference source ever on American philosophers, this biographical dictionary contains some 1,000 entries on philosophers and intellectuals who impacted philosophical thought in America from 1860 to the present.

Each entry contains a short biography of the writer, an analysis of his or her ideas, a bibliography of writings, and suggestions for further reading. While all the major post-Civil War philosophers are present, the most valuable feature of this dictionary is its coverage of less well-known writers, including a large number of female and minority thinkers, whose work has been neglected. In many cases, the *Dictionary of Modern American Philosophers* offers the first scholarly treatment of their life and work. The dictionary includes traditional areas of metaphysics, epistemology, logic, ethics, and aesthetics, but also the philosophical foundations of fields such as education, art, history, politics, psychology, and religion.
