Have spent great part of the day in getting Sarah Green out of Lynch's slave yard, where a villain named Samuel K. Wilson had kept her for six weeks. Paid him \$950 and sent her home to her Father & Mother, Alek [Alex] & Edith Green, who will gradually pay for her, – Charles Miller giving security for them doing so, in 6., 12., & 18. Mo.
