By Resolutions, appropriated

1. The Soldiers Orphan's Home Property (except 5 acres reserved), value say \$30000, to Protestant Orphan's Asylum, on certain conditions.
2. \$7500. securities, to support of Colored Orphans, in the Home on 12<sup>th</sup> St. (wh. is worth \$7000)
3. \$4500, Cash, reserved for exigencies in aid of soldiers & their families.
4. \$10,000. Sustentation fund, for students children of Union Soldiers, in Collegiate & Polytechnic Depts. of Wash. University.
5. \$30.000, To found 15 Scholarships for Children of Union Soldiers, as above. & in default of these, candidates to be recommended by Super. of Pub. Schools, & Principal of High School.
