A well-respected authority on the collective works of Leigh Hunt and Shakespeare, George Stouts (b. 1899) was affiliated with the University of Chicago, Oxford University, Harvard University, and Lake Forest College before coming to Washington University in St. Louis to become an English Professor in 1923. He was made *Professor Emeritus* in 1964.
